throughout the past 100 years.













- The children's department hosted a pajama party in July and August for children pre-k to 2nd grade.
- During the month of August the Elmora branch hosted a book and film discussion for the film, Day After Tomorrow and the book Life as We Knew It by Susan Beth Pferrer.
- On August 18th there was a magic show with Mark Zacharia and an awards ceremony to close out summer reading.
