



Elizabeth Daily Journal Digitization Project Update



The Elizabeth Public Library's Local History & Special Collections Department is currently working on the fourth and final phase of its'

Elizabeth Daily Journal Digitization Project.

This project phase is made possible by a grant from the New Jersey Historical Commission, a division of the Department of State, and administered by the Union County Office of Cultural & Heritage Affairs.

The fourth grant funded phase will pick up with the January 30, 1942 edition through December 31, 1946 edition. To finish out the project, the library will also be digitizing the remaining film through December 1991! Beginning June 3rd, 2024, *Elizabeth Daily Journal* microfilm will be inaccessible until the digitization project is finished. The database will be updated as reels of microfilm are digitized and is accessible at www.elizpl.org/databases.html

Webinars and in-person workshops on the use of the database are tentatively being planned for later in the fall.
